TC PipeLines, LP Increases 2016 Second Quarter Cash Distribution by Six Percent

HOUSTON, Texas – **July 21, 2016** – TC PipeLines, LP (NYSE: TCP) (the Partnership) today announced that the board of directors of TC PipeLines GP, Inc., its general partner, declared the Partnership's second quarter 2016 cash distribution of \$0.94 per common unit. The distribution represents a 6 percent increase from the \$0.89 per common unit paid in first quarter 2016.

This cash distribution is the 69th consecutive quarterly distribution paid by the Partnership and is payable on August 12, 2016 to unitholders of record at the close of business on August 1, 2016.

TC PipeLines, LP is a Delaware master limited partnership with interests in seven federally regulated U.S. interstate natural gas pipelines which serve markets in the Western, Midwestern and Eastern United States. The Partnership is managed by its general partner, TC PipeLines GP, Inc., a subsidiary of TransCanada Corporation (NYSE: TRP).
